SOUTH AFRICAN RESERVE BANK ANNOUNCES ANOTHER RATE CUT

Good news if you have a home loan or are paying off your car.

Another interest rate cut was announced on Thursday 21 May 2020 – this time by 0.5%. This is the fourth rate cut this year already, taking the total interest rate decrease to 2.75% with the prime lending rate now at 7.25%.

The Reserve Bank has provided this relief in the wake of the Covid-19 economic fall out and many consumers will be sighing with relief with significant easing on their stretched budgets.
